

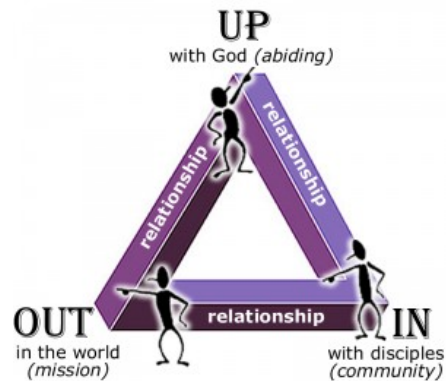
UP, IN, & OUT
