James 1:5-8 (ESV)

⁵ If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask God, who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given him. ⁶ But let him ask in faith, with no doubting, for the one who doubts is like a wave of the sea that is driven and tossed by the wind.

⁷ For that person must not suppose that he will receive anything from the Lord;

⁸ he is a double-minded man, unstable in all his ways.

James 1:2-4 (PNT)

"When all kinds of trials and temptations crowd into your lives my brothers, don't resent them as intruders, but welcome them as friends!

Realize that they come to test your faith and to produce in you the quality of endurance.

But let the process go on until that endurance is fully developed, and you will find you have become men of mature character...

And if, in the process, any of you does not know how to meet any particular problem..."
